Before the Installation


- 1. Check the package and confirm all parts are included. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact us.
- 2. Do not disassemble the main body, as it has been installed & commissioned correctly & precisely before leaving the factory.
- 3. Shut off the main water supply prior to beginning installation.
- 4. Do flush the water supply lines to remove any dirt and debris before installation (IMPORTANT).
- 5. Make sure to connect the hot/cold inlet pipe correctly. If standing in front, connect hot water pipe to the left and cold water pipe to the right.
- 6. After the installation, check for leaks and make sure every joint is safely sealed.

Cleaning and Maintenance


- 1. Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft cloth.
- 2. Do not use any detergent, acid, polisher, abrasives, or harsh cleaners.
- 3. Do not use cloth with a coarse surface.




Slide the base (A), rubber washers (B) and mounting nuts (C) onto pipes (D).




2.Secure the base (A) in place with washers and nuts. Then connect the pipes (D) to water supplies in the floor.




3. Add rubber washers (B) and connect pipes (D) to the faucet body (E) by threading the connector nuts (F) onto pipes (D) securely.



4. Add the rubber washers (B) to both ends of the shower hose (G) and connect the shower hose (G) to hand shower (H) and faucet body (E).



5. Place the hand shower (H) into the hand shower holder (I).



6. Turn on the water supplies and let water run for at least 1 minute to flush any debris.
